A beautiful little prayer given to Venerable Sr. Consolata and one for us to pray over and over.

The month of May brings to mind and heart the Blessed Mother. This month dedicated to her keeps us focused on Mary, our Mother and Queen. We pray the rosary with great devotion to her as our Blessed Mother and remember her as the Queen of Heaven as we place crowns of flowers on her images. The Sacred Congregation for Divine Worship tells us, "The queen symbol was attributed to Mary because she was a perfect follower of Christ, who is the absolute 'crown' of creation. She is the Mother of the Son of God, who is the messianic King. Mary is the Mother of Christ, the Word Incarnate ... Mary is the perfect follower of Christ."

The month of June gives us the devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. This devotion reminds us of the great love and mercy that Jesus, True God and True Man, our Redeemer and King has for us and the revelation of the depth of God's love. We all know that May is the month of Mary. This is the time of year when all the Catholic school children and parishes conduct traditional May crownings. There is usually a procession, singing of hymns, reading from Scriptures and recitation of prayers, and then Mary is usually crowned with a wreath of flowers. Some of us even have May altars where we can express special devotion during the month, especially the recitation of the Rosary.

Pope Pius XII said, "The custom of the family recitation of the Holy Rosary is a most efficacious means. What a sweet sight - most pleasing to God - when, at eventide, the Christian home resounds with the frequent repetition of praises in honor of the High Queen of Heaven! Then the Rosary, recited in the family, assembled before the image of the Virgin, in an admirable union of hearts, the parents and their children, who come back from their daily work. It unites them piously with those absent and those dead. It links all more tightly in a sweet bond of love, with the most Holy Virgin, who, like a loving mother, in the circle of her children, will be there bestowing upon them an abundance of the gifts of concord and family peace."



"Bring flowers of the rarest, bring flowers of the fairest from garden and woodland and hillside and dale ..." Will we bring Mary flowers of love, of patience, flowers of faith to reflect the perfect faith that She had at the Annunciation and all through Her life? What will our special gifts to Her be this month? She was the perfect follower of Christ; we can follow Her perfect example and strive for perfection in our own lives. As Mary is God's Crown of Creation, with the flowers of spring, we crown Her as Queen of Heaven, Queen of Earth, Queen of Peace ... We celebrate and honor the Sacred Heart of Jesus this month. His Sacred Heart represents His love for all mankind. Devotion to His Sacred Heart is a way to express our gratitude for His mercy and love. We must never forget the sacrifice He made by dying for us.

This is a good month to start spending time in Adoration. Ask Jesus present in the Eucharist to remove all our human failings that keep us from living holy lives, to purify our hearts, make them like His own and unite our hearts to His forever. Put your trust in His love while expressing your own love for Him. Get a picture or statue of the Sacred Heart in our homes as a reminder of all He did – and still does – for us.

Pope St. John Paul II said, "For evangelization today, the Heart of Christ must be recognized as the heart of the Church: It is He who calls us to conversion, to reconciliation. It is He who leads pure hearts and those hungering for justice along the way of the Beatitudes. It is He who achieves the warm communion of the members of the one Body. It is He who enables us to adhere to the Good News and to accept the promise of eternal life. It is He who sends us out on mission. The heart-to-heart with Jesus broadens the human heart on a global scale."

As Avilas, ask Jesus especially this month, to gather His priests more and more into His heart of love and comfort so they can have strength to persevere in their work. Pray for more priestly vocations. Without priests, there would be no Masses and no Eucharist.
