We were pleased to host Father Sean Donnelly as our May speaker. He was born in Rhode Island, the eldest of 13 children. He grew up in a solid Catholic family, and their parents took them to church every Sunday. The family moved frequently; they lived in many different places and the children attended many different schools. His interest in the priesthood began at the age of 20, and he attributes much of his vocation to the prayers of his grandmother. He studied at St. Mary Seminary (while it was still on Ansel Road) and at Borromeo. He was ordained on January 16, 1982, on one of the oldest days of the year. Since his ordination, he has served in five parishes, in addition to serving a Military Chaplain in the United States Air Force during the Persian Gulf War.

Father Donnelly was blessed to have visited Lourdes and Rome many times. He suggested that we too can make pilgrimages without going overseas, and listed many places we could go. He has a passion for the unborn, and began participating in the Rosary for Life each first Saturday in 1994. He knows that there is strength in the number of people who pray for the closing of abortion facilities, and he has been a witness to this miracle. He is a compassionate priest, and his mission as a priest is to bring people to Jesus by encouraging frequent visits to the Blessed Sacrament, praying the Rosary and attending daily Mass whenever possible. He offers Confession on Saturday evenings and after every weekend Mass.

Father Donnelly is glad he heard the Lord's call, and so are we!

# SPIRITUAL PARENTHOOD



Spiritual maternity and paternity are gifts of the Holy Spirit who is a vessel of life-giving grace.

Spiritual mothers and fathers are men and women of grace and virtue, the greatest of which is charity. Love by its nature is self-giving, and spiritual mothers and fathers place themselves at the service of God's plan for the salvation of souls. Spiritual parenthood is love in action, the response of their love for Jesus.

Those called to spiritual maternity and paternity of priests must have a readiness to stand by all priests, but in particular for the particular priest entrusted to them.

Spiritual parents are virtuous men and women whose lives are centered on God. They should do their best to avoid anything that would impede their own growth in holiness: unforgiveness, hardness of heart, pride, etc. The most effective means of our overcoming obstacles to holiness include frequent Confession and Holy Communion, meditation on God's Word, adoration before the Blessed Sacrament, and adhering to the Commandments.

As spiritual mothers look to Our Lady as guides for spiritual maternity, spiritual fathers can look to St. Joseph for guidance in spiritual paternity. They are the perfect intercessors for our spiritual parenthood.

We should be confident in the fact that some day we will see the eternal effects that our prayers and sacrifices have had for our spiritual sons!

### INTERCEDING FOR OUR SPIRITUAL SONS

- Devote one Holy Hour each week to your spiritual sons which will draw graces upon them, specifically
  offering prayers of spiritual warfare as protection for them.
- Offer your Holy Communion for your spiritual sons on the first Friday, Saturday or Sunday, asking Jesus for an infusion of His divine love.
- Dedicate one small sacrifice each day for your spiritual son.
- Recite one Rosary a week for your spiritual son, asking Our Lady to keep him safe in the refuge of her Immaculate Heart.
- Recite one Divine Mercy Chaplet a week for your spiritual son that he might become a vessel of mercy for others.
- Send them frequent notes of encouragement, not just for their birthday or anniversary of their ordination, but for holidays or any time throughout the year. Set a goal of monthly written communication.
- Send them a spiritual bouquet a few times a year, letting them know exactly how you pray for them.
- Pray daily or weekly to a saint who is a patron for priests, such as St. John Vianney, St. Thomas Becket, St. Charles Borromeo or St. Monica.

# Specific prayer intentions may include:

- For your spiritual son to be blessed with expectant faith, constant hope and the fullness of God's love.
- For your spiritual son to be grounded in the humility of the one eternal High Priest who lowered Himself to become a servant of all.
- For your spiritual son to be blessed with the grace to faithfully live out their promise of celibacy, making them fully able to serve the Church with single hearted devotion.
- That your spiritual son will have the power of the Holy Spirit to animate their priesthood, especially their preaching.
